The organisation assists donors by monitoring funded programmes.

The ADN is registered with the National Department of Social Development, in terms of the Non-Profit Organisations Act 71 of 1997, as Non-Profit Organisation with registration number NPO number 217-527. The organisation has also applied to register as a Public Benefit Organisation (PBO) in terms of section 30 of the Income Tax Act, with the consequence that all receipts and accruals made in South Africa, are exempt from income tax.
